### Tasks we need help with

The tasks we need help with aren't onerous but are essential for the smooth-running of the performance. We want you to enjoy the performance as much as the audience members – and you'll be able to get a sneak peek at our dress rehearsal too.

- The main job will be helping to talk to all the audience members the general public. For
  example, many people will stumble across our performance by accident so we will need
  people to explain what we're up to don't worry, we'll give you plenty of training and BCMG
  staff will be on hand for any tricky questions.
- The towpath can be pretty narrow and we're hoping for a big crowd, so we need people to help keep the towpath clear and keep people moving.
